
The platform provides:

This is a reference hospital, with a second level department for accidents and emergencies, has a capacity of 581 beds serving approximately 650,000 inhabitants. The Department of Research and Innovation (DAIRI) works to identify and promote synergies between scientific research and healthcare activities, coordinates multidisciplinary corporate research, training and innovation workgroups called ”disease units” in order to develop healthcare and research focusing on environmental pathologies.
